Reminders on the use of lawn bowls greens

Care for the outdoor greens

Bowling greens are delicate and maintenance is difficult work. The lawn conditions should be respected. Players must -

- Wear proper footwear;
- Not drop or toss bowls on the green. Pick up and put down or kick them along with your feet;
- Not pour liquids other than plain water (beer, coffee, etc.) onto the green;
- Make sure your delivery does not damage the green or cause scuff marks. If it is, try to bowl more gently;
- Place the mats by hand and not dragging them along or kicking them into position;
- Take off the mat when not in use from the grass;
- Use groundsheets on wet days to protect the grass.

Care for the indoor green

- Players must wear proper flat smooth soled lawn bowl shoes while using the green. They must ensure that the lawn bowl shoes are clean before stepping onto the green.
- No eating or drinking on any area covered by the indoor bowling carpet.
- No smoking

Use of greens

The Greens Manager has been authorised by The Convenor to deal with all operational matters related to the green. In general, the greens are available to all members regardless of their standard of play. However, if they do not observe these rules or cause nuisance to other players, the Greens Manager is authorised to take necessary measures to protect the greens and other users.

Greens will be available for play on a first come first serve bases. Unless no other players are waiting, no players may alone occupy a rink. With less than eight playing in a rink, every opportunity should be given for other players in waiting to join in.

Reservations

The Subcommittee may, in its discretion, reserve the greens or parts thereof for whatever purpose it deems necessary.

Relevant rinks can be reserved for team practice for specified time slots every Thursday (as team practice day) for teams who will be playing on home grounds that week. Requests should be made to the Office by the relevant team Captains.

Members may reserve specific rinks for their own matches in club or national tournaments. At least one clear day advance notice to the Office is required.

Reserved ranks may be available for use by other members until one hour before the starting time.

While every opportunity will be given to reservation requests, the interests of other members will also be taken into consideration e.g. not all indoor rinks may be reserved for a particular session especially during wet weather.

Direction of rinks

As a general rule, outdoor rinks will be from east-west (towards the tramway) from Thursday to Saturday and north-south (towards Sports Road) from Sunday to Wednesday. The boundary lines of rinks will be decided by the Greens Manager having regard to the wear and tear conditions of the greens. In other words, there will be no fixed boundary lines for a particular team for a particular season.
