

# Measures against Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

As the Novel Coronavirus has spread widely, the government announced that the response level was raised to Emergency level. The Club has taken a series of preventive/disinfection measures to combat the COVID-19 epidemic with the view to prevent users of the Club facilities and our staff from being infected. These measures include the following:

1. SGS Hong Kong Limited was engaged to conduct scientific tests on the air quality of the indoor facilities.
2. To prevent our Members from being infected, the sports & recreational facilities including Badminton Courts, Billiard Room, Cards Rooms, Changing Rooms, Children Playroom, Outdoor Children Playground, Cricket / Golf Driving Range, Darts Room, Gymnasium, Jacuzzi, Karaoke Rooms, Lawn Bowls Greens (both Outdoor and Covered Greens), Multi-activities Room, Quiet Rooms, Squash Courts, Sauna Rooms, Steam Rooms, Swimming Pool, Table Tennis Room, and Tennis Courts (both Outdoor and Covered Courts) have been temporarily closed until further notice.
3. All interest classes are suspended and major sports competition have been postponed.
4. Any gatherings of more than four persons is prohibited unless it is specifically exempted under relevant rules and regulations.
5. The number of tables inside the two dining rooms, the Old Corner, the Family Lounge & the Centenary Bar have been reduced so as to increase the space between tables. Each dining table is separated by least 1.5 m and only four people can be seated at a table.
6. The floor of the Centenary Building, Clubhouse Building and Members' Changing Rooms will be disinfected with bleach/cleaned every three to four hours.
7. A hand sanitizer dispenser has been installed at the lobby and near the lift doors on each floor of the Centenary Building and Clubhouse Building for Members and guests to disinfect their hands.
8. The buttons inside and outside each lift are covered with a transparent plastic film which will be disinfected with bleach about every two hours.
9. A notice is put up inside each toilet compartment to remind users to close the toilet lid before flushing to prevent bacteria from floating around.
10. Staff have been assigned to disinfect and clean the handrails of all doors about every two hours
11. All frontline staff on duty, including the kitchen staff, should wear a mask.
12. Anyone who enters the Club should have his or her body temperature checked to ensure he or she is healthy. People with fever will be asked to seek medical advice immediately.
13. All persons visiting the Club are required to sign a Health Declaration Form.
14. Any person (Member, guest, coach, staff or contractor) who has symptoms associated with Covid-19 infection (ie. fever [ $37.5^{\circ}\text{C}$  or above] malaise, dry cough, shortness of breath, headache or other flu-like symptoms) will be denied entry to the Club premises.
15. Any person having close contact with a Covid-19 patient will be denied entry to the Club premises.
16. Any person who has been in close contact with someone who arrived in Hong Kong from the Covid-19 affected countries and regions should not visit the Club for a period of 14 days.
17. Any person undergoing 14-day quarantine is not allowed to enter the Club premises.

We care for the health of Members and their families as well as our staff. We will try our best to provide a healthy, safe and hygienic environment inside the Club to prevent them from being infected. However, we still call on everyone to be aware of personal hygiene, wear a mask and clean both hands frequently. People with upper respiratory tract infection symptoms should seek medical advice as soon as possible.
