## Guidelines on Appointment of Sub-committee Members

- 1. Appointments to a sub-committee are based on the merits of proposed members in terms of experience, professional expertise and achievements in relevant sports, as well as a need to maintain a diversity of membership in terms of age group, gender, professions, and previous sub-committee experience.
- 2. Government policy on appointment to statutory bodies that a member shall not serve on a committee for over 6 years shall be observed.
- 3. A vice chairman shall be appointed for each sub-committee for taking up the chairmanship in the absence of the chairman, and for succession planning purposes.
- 4. Other than the Audit Committee and Disciplinary Sub-committee, each sub-committee shall comprise at least one GC member who will foster better communications between the GC and the sub-committee.
- 5. Each sub-committee shall comprise 3 to 12 members including the chairman. The 4 Club Officers being the ex officio members are not counted towards the above "3 to 12 members", and these ex officio members do not have voting rights at the sub-committee decision-making processes, nor their presence be counted for quorum purposes.
- 6. A member shall not be appointed to more than 3 sub-committees in the same term.
